OUR OFFICERS AND EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

Our President attends the annual American Inns of Court "Celebration of Excellence" and our officers and Executive Committee members are encouraged to attend, and often attend, the AIC Leadership Summits.

OUR OFFICER NOMINATING COMMITTEE

The Officer Nominating Committee consists of two members of our Executive Committee and two members at large. Our Nominating Committee is appointed by our President to propose a slate of officers and Executive Committee members for consideration by the membership at our May Meeting, the final meeting of the term, which is called in large part for the purpose of election of officers and the Executive Committee and to celebrate the success of the term.

ELECTIONS AND TERMS OF OFFICE

Our Officer Nominating Committee presents the slate of officers and Executive Committee members to the membership and further nominations may be made from the floor. All officers, are elected by a majority vote of the members present. The President-Elect succeeds to the office of President the following term. VACANCIES

Vacancies in any other office arising from any cause are filled for the unexpired portion of the term by the Executive Committee at the next Executive Committee meeting.
