CURRENT INN NEWS TO AMERICAN INNS OF COURT

ELDON B. MAHON INN OF COURT EXPANDED COMMUNITY SERVICE PROJECTS 2013-2014 INN YEAR

The Eldon B. Mahon Inn of Court launched a greatly expanded "Community Outreach" effort for the 2013-2014 Inn Year. Instead of one Community Outreach project performed by the Inn as a whole, the Inn's eleven Pupilage Groups (each group consisting of two Masters, two Barristers, four Associates, and one Pupil) each were challenged to plan and execute a separate Pupilage Group Community Outreach project. All eleven Pupilage Groups have now reported completion of their respective Community Outreach projects for the 2013-2014 Inn Year.

The Tarrant County (Texas) Food Bank, National Adoption Day, two Texas A&M Law School (Fort Worth, Texas) projects, Ronald McDonald House at Cook Children's Hospital, Fort Worth, and the Tarrant County Bar Association's free Legal Line were recipients of separate projects by one of the Inn's eleven Pupilage Groups. These Community Outreach projects included packaging food for children at Tarrant County Food Bank, books and bears and administrative staff for National Adoption Day, fund-raising for Texas A&M Law School's Public-Interest Board, judges and administrative staff for Texas A&M Law School's high school moot court competition, evening dinner to current residents at the Ronald McDonald House at Cook Children's Hospital in Fort Worth, and volunteer staffing at the free-to-the-public Legal Line program. These Community Outreach projects required an estimated total of more than two hundred twenty-five hours of Pupilage Group planning and execution and involved the personal involvement and effort of the more than one hundred Inn members in the eleven Pupilage Groups.
