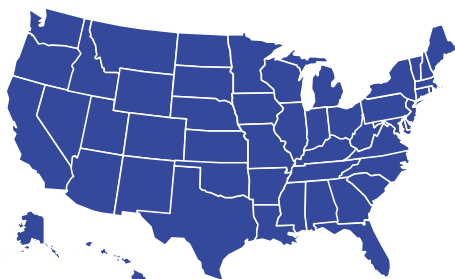

HISTORY: Conceived by Chief Justice Warren E. Burger, the first American Inn of Court was founded in 1980; American Inns of Court Foundation was established in 1985

THE AMERICAN INNS OF COURT NATIONAL ORGANIZATION

- Establishes and charters **new** American Inns of Court and Inns of Transactional Counsel
- Assists and strengthens **existing** Inns
- Administers the **Achieving Excellence** program
- Employs dedicated **Chapter Relations Directors** who provide assistance, answer questions, and support Inns
- Provides IRS **group tax exemption** status
- Provides general **liability and umbrella insurance** policies
- Offers an **Inn Management System (IMS)** that Inns can use to manage their operations, send e-mails and meeting notices to their members, among other functions
- Hosts complimentary Inn **websites**
- Offers **plaques** and membership **certificates**
- Compiles and offers **sample documents and recommendations** for bylaws, budgets, policies, and membership forms to assist Inn leaders in day-to-day Inn operations

AWARDS & SCHOLARSHIPS

- **A. Sherman Christensen Award** recognizes members who have provided distinguished, exceptional, and significant leadership to the American Inns of Court
- **Lewis F. Powell, Jr. Award for Professionalism and Ethics** recognizes individuals who have demonstrated exemplary service in the areas of professionalism, ethics, civility, and excellence
- **Sandra Day O'Connor Award for Professional Service** recognizes members for excellence in public interest or pro bono activities
- **Warren E. Burger Prize**, a writing competition promoting scholarship in the areas of professionalism, ethics, civility, and excellence
- **American Inns of Court Professionalism Awards** recognize lawyers and judges whose life and practice demonstrate the highest standards of the legal profession and the rule of law
- **Program Awards** recognize exceptional programs created and presented by Inns
- **Best Special Project Award** given for a substantive Inn activity or enterprise that reaches the local legal community or community at-large
- **Temple Bar Scholarships®** allows young attorneys to spend a month in London to experience and study the English legal system.
- **Pegasus Scholarship Trust**, a six-week exchange program for young American and British lawyers and barristers to learn about each other's legal systems

EDUCATION & MENTORING

- Offers quality educational programs available in a national **Program Library**
- Holds regional **Leadership Summits**, to bring together Inn leaders to exchange ideas and learn effective practices
- Publishes **The Benchers®**, a bimonthly magazine with articles on professionalism, ethics, timely topics, and Inn news.
- Sponsors **national education programs** such as the National Advocacy Training Program
- Offers online education program through the **INNnovation Education** portal
- Assists with **CLE** approval for national programs
- Provides mentoring resources including a **Model Mentoring Program**, samples, and templates
- Offers online **leadership training and program development** resources
- **Develops leaders** through board service, committee, and task force participation

- **Represents** Inns nationally and internationally
- **Promotes** the American Inns of Court and **maintains contact** with national, state, and local legal organizations
- **Fosters an understanding** of the American Inns of Court with the judiciary
- Cultivates **relationships with law schools** to increase awareness of American Inns of Court
